

Preschool Supplies | September

Now that you have all the supplies you need for Church @ Home, each Sunday logon to our website journeyoffaith.com/kids/ to find the videos for each week.

September 6

First Activity

- **Connect the Dots Coat**
 - “Dot to Dot Coat” [Click here to print](#)
 - Crayons or markers

Give the “Dot to Dot Coat” to each child. Encourage the children to connect the dots on the page to reveal the coat. Children may color the picture after connecting the dots. **Say** Connect all the dots to see what it is. You can also color the coat. Make it as colorful as you like!

Second Activity

- **Color the Coat**
 - “Coat Template” [Click here to print](#)
 - Permanent markers
 - Scissors
 - Medium-size piece of felt
 - Smaller felt pieces in various colors
 - Glue

Cut the “Coat Template” on the dotted lines. Lay the template on top of the medium-size felt piece. If you do not have felt, color the coat with crayons or markers. Trace around the template. Remove the template and cut the felt on the lines. You should have a felt “coat.” Cut the smaller felt pieces into different shapes such as circles, rectangles, squares, and triangles. Use these colorful shapes to decorate the coat. Pick a shape and lay it on the coat and glue it to the coat. Let’s see how colorful we can make this coat!”

September 13

First Activity

- **In Charge**
 - No supplies needed

Have the children stand up and let them know that they must follow the video host and mimic what she does. Lead the children around the room while marching. If you would like to continue the game after Church @ Home, choose a child to be the new leader and “in charge.” Continue with the activity by allowing all of the children a turn to be “in charge.”

Second Activity

- **What Happened Next?**
 - Story pictures
 - [Click here to print in color](#)
 - [Click here to print B&W](#)
 - Scissors

Print the story pictures. Give each family member their very own story cards. Everyone needs to put their story cards in the order they happened in the story. They can put at the end the “God has a plan for me” card.

(Hold up the picture where Potiphar is happy with Joseph.) “Look for this picture of Potiphar. He’s smiling at Joseph because Joseph always worked hard and did what Potiphar told him to do. What happened next?”

(Hold up the picture of angry Potiphar with Joseph.) “Look for this picture, this is Potiphar again, only this time he has an angry face. Someone told him that Joseph had done something wrong, even though he didn’t do anything wrong. Potiphar got mad and sent Joseph to jail! What happened next?”

(Hold up the picture of Joseph in jail.) “Now, look for this picture of Joseph in jail. It was a very hard time for Joseph, but he still trusted that God loved him and had a plan for him. So, instead of being mad or sad, Joseph helped everyone he could while he was in jail.

(Hold up the ‘God has a plan for me’ card.) “Okay, I have this card left. Do you see a picture? No. But it does have some very important words. This card says, ‘**God has a plan for me.**’ You can put this card at the end to remind us that God’s plans are always good!”

Now it’s time to pause the video and put in order your story pictures!!! Have fun!

September 20

First Activity

- **Scoop**
 - Yellow cotton balls
 - Floor tape
 - Plastic spoon

Make a large circle on the floor with the tape. Spread the cotton balls all around the outside of the circle. The cotton balls will represent grain. Give each child a shovel (*spoon*) and encourage them to scoop the grain into the circle.

Second Activity

- **Medallion**
 - “Medallion” activity page. [Click here to print](#)
 - Hole puncher
 - Scissors
 - Yarn
 - Tape
 - Straws

Copy “Medallion” onto cardstock and cut out, one per child. Punch a hole in the top of each cutout. Cut yarn into two-foot lengths and tape around one end, one length of yarn per child. Cut straws into one-inch pieces. “Let’s make a necklace to help us remember that **God has a plan for me**. That’s what your medallion says. String some of these straw pieces and the medallion onto the yarn.

September 27

First Activity

- **Freeze Dance**
 - No supplies needed

Have the children stand up and follow the video Host instructions. “We’re going to dance, but we have to really use our ears to know what to do!” If the kids would like to continue doing this activity, pause the video. Turn the music on and ask the children to dance. After about 30 seconds, turn off the music and ask the children to stand very still or FREEZE. Restart the music and ask the children to dance again. Repeat the activity several times in 30 second increments.

Second Activity

- **Memory Match**
 - “Memory Match” Activity page two sets. [Click here to print](#)
 - Scissors

Place each card face down on the floor or table. Ask one child to go first by choosing two cards and turning them over. If they match, remove both cards and set them aside. If they don’t match, turn both of the cards back over in the same place. In both cases, allow another child to have a turn. Repeat until all of the matches have been made and every one has had a turn.
